Chairman Meursing referred to the new Resolution before the Commissioners, to waive competitive bidding requirements with respect to a potential purchase of a mini-pumper apparatus, as has been discussed at previous meetings.

#### F. CHIEF'S REPORT

Assistant Chief Shields presented and submitted Chief Carleton's Chief Officer Report.

Of particular note is that preparations have begun for the Annual Hallowe'en Haunted House event, scheduled for October 27, 2018, at 2:00 pm, at the Fire Hall. Volunteers are organizing the event which has become very popular with families over the years.

Additionally, every year the Members of Fire District 5 design and print t-shirts for participating members, to promote awareness of Breast Cancer during October and Prostate Cancer during November. That campaign is currently ongoing.

Assistant Chief Shields reported that 265 calls have been attended to this year, one more than all of 2017. This will be another record year for calls attended.
