### C.1 Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2015

**MOTION:** Commissioner Riffle moved to accept the Minutes of the February  $11^{th}$  2015 meeting as read. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilmot. **Motion passed** 3-0.

#### D. 2 Approval of Fire District Vouchers

Discussion ensued regarding Financial Manager Kinsey's attendance at Auditor's meeting on new online year-end procedures, to clarify that the time and mileage costs of her attendance at that meeting were split 50/50 with the Hospital District as she attended on behalf of both organizations.

Commissioner Riffle initiated further discussion for clarification of overage of cost to Mt. Baker Roofing, wherein Chief Carleton explained additional work and materials required due to rot in the roof area that had not been anticipated in the original bid process, confirming that although the cost is over \$15,000 bid, it remained below \$20,000 threshold.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Riffle moved to accept the Vouchers for March, 2015 in the amount of \$38,015.74 for payment. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilmot. **Motion passed 3-0** 

#### D.3 Approval of Fire District Payroll

**MOTION:** Commissioner Riffle moved that the payroll in the amount of \$15,626.34 be approved for payment. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilmot. **Motion** passed 3-0

#### E. CORRESPONDENCE

#### F. CHIEF'S REPORT

Chief Carleton provided an overview of the Chief Officer Report as attached and scanned. Chief's report included a slideshow reviewing results of a propagation study of current and potential communications capacity between Point Roberts and the emergency dispatch center known as Prospect. Chief's Report also included an update on anticipated costs to implement proposed communications upgrade being higher than previously anticipated due to necessary equipment upgrades at Prospect.

**MOTION:** Commissioner Riffle moved to approve the emergency procurement requested by Chief Carleton, not to exceed \$70,000, being an increase of \$20,000 over the emergency procurement approved last month, for expenditures related to upgraded communication equipment and services, noting that the Board anticipates full implementation of the upgrades as soon as possible, pending confirmation of a communication relay agreement with either Department of Homeland Security, State Patrol, or Sheriff's office, to be negotiated. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilmot. **Motion passed 3 - 0.**

#### H. NEW BUSINESS

Discussion ensued about the possibility of procuring new microphones to enhance the audio quality of videotaped Commissioner meetings. The Chief will look into options for better audio recording of meetings.

An inquiry arose from audience member Judson Meraw about training sessions for ham radio operation. At this time WCFD5 does not provide ham radio training, although Chief agreed to send an email to members to solicit potential interest in such training.

As there was no further business, Commissioner Wilmot moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:34 p.m. Commissioner Riffle seconded the motion. **Motion passed 3 – 0.**
