#### F. CHIEF'S REPORT

Chief Carleton submitted and reviewed his report for the month of May, 2024.

Chief reported that our District was part of a grant awarded to several other fire districts, which he had co-applied for to cover the cost of certain supplies, i.e. 5-gas monitors and foam. He noted that our district already has 4-gas monitors which are efficient for our needs and so he would rather spend the allotted grant money on more foam.

Chief continued that the new HVAC system installation was complete.

Chief gave an overview of the National Fire Academy course that was held on June 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. CERT members were invited, as were the Commissioners and other local organizations.

Chief reported that the Fire Marshall had advised that a burn ban will be implemented on July 1<sup>st</sup> and he feels that this will become the new annual standard, rather than waiting to assess the danger levels. Recreational fires will still be allowed at this time.

Total calls for the month were 40.
